Title: ALDI Resolves Claim Regarding "Sustainable" Marketing of Fresh Atlantic Salmon Products

ALDI has resolved a lawsuit brought by Toxin Free USA in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia alleging that claims on ALDI fresh Atlantic salmon products misled consumers. The suit was resolved without any admission or court decision on whether ALDI had acted improperly or illegally in the marketing of its salmon products.

The fresh Atlantic salmon products sold at ALDI are primarily supplied by salmon suppliers certified under Best Aquaculture Practices (BAP) standards. BAP standards focus on safe, responsible, and ethical farm-raised seafood built on the four pillars of responsibility: environmental responsibility, animal health & welfare, food safety, and social accountability. ALDI will begin sourcing some of its fresh Atlantic salmon from aquaculture facilities certified by the Aquaculture Stewardship Counsel or Global Animal Partnership.
