In Association with Treehouse Foods, Inc., ALDI Voluntarily Recalls Tuscan Garden Restaurant Style Italian Dressing Products Sold in the U.S. due to Mislabeling and Potential for Undeclared Allergens

Batavia, Ill. (September 23, 2022) – In cooperation with Treehouse Foods, Inc., and out of an abundance of caution, ALDI is voluntarily recalling all 16 oz. plastic jars of Tuscan Garden Restaurant Style Italian Dressing products sold at its stores across the U.S. This is a precautionary measure due to mislabeling and the potential for contamination with undeclared allergens, which include wheat and soy.

Upon notification from the supplier, ALDI immediately removed the affected products from all stores in the U.S. The items were also available for purchase through the company's partnership with Instacart, a grocery delivery service.
