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In Association with Schulze & Burch, ALDI Expands Voluntarily Recall of Two Types of Millville Protein Chewy Bars in Seven States

Batavia, Ill. (June 3, 2016) – In cooperation with Schulze & Burch, and out of an abundance of caution, ALDI has expanded its voluntary recall of Millville Peanut Butter Dark Chocolate Protein Chewy Bars and Peanut, Almond and Dark Chocolate Protein Chewy Bars due to possible Listeria monocytogenes contamination to include an expanded list of “best by” dates in seven states.

Upon notification from the supplier, ALDI immediately removed the affected products from its stores.
