This will save over 4,400 tons (nearly nine million pounds) of plastic from circulation each year. That's equivalent to 20 Lady Liberty statues! With this important change, we'd like to remind you to bring your own reusable bags whenever you shop at an ALDI store or purchase one of our exclusive reusable bags at checkout. Shopping with a reusable bag is a small but mighty way we can all support a healthier planet.

We also unveiled a **new industry-leading goal to transition to natural refrigerants across all U.S. stores by 2035**. Environmentally friendly refrigeration systems help keep our products fresh while limiting our impact on the planet. We already use environmentally friendly refrigerants in more than 600 stores, which has helped ALDI save nearly 60% of potential carbon emissions each year and earn recognition from the [EPA GreenChill program](#) for five consecutive years.
